#### **EAST AFRICA**

Some parts of East Africa are currently suffering from the worst drought for 60 years. Rains have failed for the past three seasons and more than 12 million people across large parts of Ethiopia, Somalia and Kenya are facing dire shortages of food, shelter and health services. Unprecedented numbers of children and babies are suffering from malnutrition, many are dying. 1300 people are arriving each day at a refugee camp in Kenya.

We are launching an ERA appeal to raise funds to help those suffering so badly. Chris Jones, our International Missions Director, is currently in East Africa meeting with leaders of our Elim Churches there to find the best way to help. Pray for God to bless and protect him in all he does. Pray many Fulanis will come to know Christ as their Saviour through this ministry.

#### **CONGO**

Debbie Howard is on home leave in the UK. Pray this will be a time of rest and refreshment for her. Pray for safety as she travels to churches sharing about her ministry.

#### **GHANA**

The Church of Pentecost has established churches in over 70 nations on all continents. Pray that God will bless and guide the Chairman, Apostle Dr Opoko Onyinah, and the General Council as they lead the Church.

#### **ZIMBABWE**

Geoff Saunders arrived in the UK on Wednesday to spend time with his sister Annie who has cancer and has been told the doctors can do no more. Pray for Geoff, Annie and the family. Up to now Annie does not have faith in Jesus and his promise of eternal life. Pray that Geoff will be able to share with her about the wonderful grace and love of Jesus and that she will commit her life to Him.

#### **SWAZILAND**

It's been reported that Swaziland's State hospitals have only two months supplies of AIDS drugs and do not have the finances to buy more. Over 60,000 Swazis depend on anti-retroviral AIDS drugs (ARVs) and more than a quarter of Swazis between the ages of 15 and 19 are believed to carry HIV. Pray for a breakthrough so that the much needed ARVs can be obtained. Pray for a miraculous move of God to take place in Swaziland.



#### **INDIA**

Pray for Roger and Rebeccah to have wisdom to know which children to take into their homes. There are more needy children than there is room. Pray the Punjab authorities will approve and install a connecting road to their site before the monsoon rains, which is very soon.

#### **BRAZIL**

The four Daniels have arrived safely with Martin and Rebeca Davison. Pray God will continue to protect and guide them in all they do during this month in the Amazon.

#### **ISRAEL**

Pray for Christian workers and organisations to be protected. Pray that through various evangelistic programmes, including websites, radio and TV, people will be convicted by the Holy Spirit of the truth of the gospel whenever they hear, see or read about it.
