#### **EAST AFRICA**

They don't know if they will live to the next day. People have lost all their livestock, shelter and lifestyle. And the crisis is only going to get worse over the coming months."

#### **ZIMBABWE**

Sadly Geoff Saunders' sister Annie died on 13<sup>th</sup> July after being more or less unconscious for a couple of days. Geoff was due to return to Zimbabwe on Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> July but has delayed his flight until after the funeral takes place. Please pray that God will uphold Geoff and all the family at this difficult time.

#### **HAITI**

Please pray for the six ladies that Jackie Griffiths and Becky Haldane are training in the Bible curriculum at Samaritan's Purse. Pray the ladies will learn well and grasp hold of the truths so that they between them can teach the material the following week to 360 women. Pray that each of the women will grow strong in their Christian faith and for those who do not yet know the Lord that they will come to know Him.

It is rainy season in Haiti so please pray for people still living in tent camps as the rain makes life very difficult for them. Pray too that the incidence of cholera will not increase as a result of the rains.

#### **CONGO**

Please pray for Nick and Kym Delpont and their colleagues in Congo. Because of the cold, on Tuesday night two of the workers on guard duty lit a charcoal brazier in their tent and sadly died as a result of monoxide poisoning. Such an accident can trigger a dangerous reaction so pray for safety and calm. Pray for the bereaved families of the two men.

#### **SPAIN**

The Girona church plant in Palafrugell has grown to an attendance of around 50. Currently they are meeting in a garage and are urgently seeking larger premises. There is a new law relating to places of worship in Catalunya which has created further restrictions for evangelical churches. Pray that suitable premises will soon be located and the church is able to move without any problems.

Both John and Valerie Knox have now completed their chemotherapy treatment. Pray they will quickly overcome the side effects and be strengthened afresh in the days ahead.

#### **TURKEY**

Phillip and Lynda Thomas are adjusting well to life in the UK. Continue to pray that they will feel more and more at home over these next few weeks. Pray too for the church in Antalya that everyone will be protected and that the church will be a shining witness for Jesus in that city and draw people to Him.
