



Prayerline of Elim International Missions for the week Sunday 31st July to Saturday 6th August 2011 inclusive.

MALAWI

Thank you for your prayers for Malawi and our Elim Missionaries there. The demonstrations of last week have not been repeated and the key organisers of the protests are now in hiding. Continue to pray that a peaceful resolution will be found and that no further riots will take place. Yomi Oke (Clapham) is currently working with Paul and Tracy Gill at Hope Village. Pray for a safe return on 6th August.

RAMADAN

This takes place from 1st-30th August this year, when Muslims fast from dawn to sunset each day. The month of Ramadan is a good time for us to pray for God's sovereign intervention in the lives of Muslims. In many nations it is illegal to proclaim the gospel and many Christian internet sites are blocked. Pray for a real breakthrough via ways we can't even imagine, so that the Gospel will be freely heard. Pray that the Holy Spirit will miraculously reveal Jesus through dreams and visions and people will accept him as Lord.

SWAZILAND

Donna Priestley is leading a team of nine from Northern Ireland to Swaziland from 3rd-18th August. Pray for safe travelling. Pray the team will be a real blessing to all those they minister with. Helen Munday (Derby) is also serving the ministry in Swaziland during the month of August. Pray for her, for Kevin and Helen Ward as they lead the ministry in Swaziland, and for our Elim Missionaries, Jane Bradshaw and Wendy Brown.

INDIA

Harry and Rose leave the UK on 4th August to return to India after a period of home leave. Pray that as they take up ministry again, they will be very conscious of God guiding and leading them in all they do. Pray too for Grace, who is facing considerable pressures at the moment.

EAST AFRICA

Thank you to everyone who has given to our appeal for funds to help those suffering so terribly as a result of the drought. Latest reports indicate that 10.7 million people are in need of humanitarian assistance. We have been able to send money already to Kenya to provide emergency relief supplies.
