



Prayerline of Elim International Missions for the week Sunday 3rd July to Saturday 9th July 2011 inclusive.

MACEDONIA

A team of 20 from Whitewell and 3 from Brookeborough leaves for Macedonia on 6th July for two weeks to work with the Elim church in Stip. They will be involved in outreach to villages and local parks, a concert, kid's activities, evangelism and taking aid to those in need. Pray for safety in all they do and that God will use and bless them mightily during their visit. Pray for Angel and Zoki as they lead the church in Stip and also for Elim Missionaries Tony and Norma who will be coordinating the team's activities.

SUDAN

South Sudan becomes a separate country on 9th July. There are reports of ethnic tensions fuelled by unequal access to wealth and power which could threaten to create violence and instability in Africa's newest state. Pray that the transition of South Sudan to an independent country will be peaceful and that negotiations will take place to end all violence. Pray too that agreement can be reached on ownership of the oil industry; three-quarters of the oil output comes from the south but most of the refineries, pipelines and ports are in the north.

ZAMBIA

Sybil McKillop underwent surgery a few weeks ago. Praise God she is doing well - please pray for a complete recovery to full health and strength.

HONDURAS

Pastor Peter Hannam and his wife Kath, along with Kieran and Shelley Malko, are in Tegucigalpa for three months assisting the ministry there. Pray for God's protection and blessing on them and Elim Missionaries John and Rachel McDonough in all they do.

PHILIPPINES

The City Gates Church in Manila is held in the open air and the lively worship can be heard by surrounding neighbours. Just recently one neighbour, who had felt bitter towards the church, even throwing stones at it, felt God speak to him to go to the church to know more. Praise God he returned the second week. Pray that God will continue to speak to this man and he will accept Jesus as his personal Saviour.

We have just heard news that the government has closed a popular bar where girls as young as 15 were sold to customers for sex. Pray for the rescued girls who are now receiving counselling and medical care. Praise God that the government has taken action. Pray for other governments across the globe to do the same.
