Dear all,

Firstly we would like to thank you for your prayers, love and support; we really appreciate your faithfulness and kindness.

The staff and children have settled well into the New Elim Centre. It's great to have the International Church, Khmer Church and Day Care Centre all under the one roof along with our English, computer and music teaching ministries. We continue with our bi-weekly visits to the two villages in the slum areas of Phnom Penh. On Saturday mornings we present the gospel and as a result many have come to know Jesus there.

Praise God. When we set up our Good News Club the children and many parents settle down to sing the choruses, listen to the Bible lesson and enjoy the food and the Bible picture colouring-in. Every Sunday morning we send a tuc-tuc to bring the faithful, the interested and the curious to the Elim church.

The news has spread that Elim has moved to a new building and a new location and that English, Music and Computer classes are still going on. So we have many new students each night. In February around 100 young people attended the various classes each evening with around 40 coming to hear about Jesus in the English from the Bible class on Wednesday evenings. I am delighted to report that 5 students, all in their early twenties, have become Christians over the past 3 weeks. Please pray for them. The girls are generally accepted by their families if they become Christians. However, boys are often put out of their family home. So we are monitoring the two boys' progress.

Finally, we are so pleased to have been joined by David and Esther Allen from Bangor Elim, N.Ireland. We look forward with great anticipation to see the mission develop and grow with the addition of their talents, gifting and passion for spreading the word of God.
